

ETHIC RULES

All members of the Editorial Board of the journal „Announcements of Union of Scientists - Sliven” believe in the values of ethical behavior, which is based on our individual freedom and our intellectual honesty.

The journal „Announcements of Union of Scientists - Sliven” is devoted to original scientific papers presenting clearly significant aspects, new results or new ideas of the modern science. The authors are encouraged to present high quality original works (theoretical and applied research) that have not been published or accepted for publication by other journals. However, this policy of the journal for publishing scientific papers becomes meaningless, and the science community may be disadvantaged if the authors ignore the above-mentioned values of ethical behavior. We adhere to Elsevier's existing Publishing Ethics Resource Kit and to ideology in the **Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE)** materials published in the COPE by complying with the relevant Code of Conduct, aiming to stick to the guidelines and, most importantly, best practices in this area.

We encourage the best standards for publishing ethics and take every possible precaution against the abuse of publications. The basis for this activity is to reach agreement on standards of ethical conduct by all parties involved in publishing works: authors, editors, reviewers and publishers.

Plagiarism: Plagiarism occurs when one author uses another work (usually work of another author) without permission. Plagiarism takes different forms, from literal copying to paraphrasing the work of another. The „Announcements of Union of Scientists – Sliven“ is obliged to publish only original materials. The authors are responsible for ensuring that all data in the article is real and authentic.

Duplication or self-plagiarism: If the authors (or one author) have used their own previously published work or work currently under review as the basis for a manuscript they should quote the previous work and indicate how the submitted manuscript offers new materials other than those of the previous work.

Sanctions: If there are documented violations of any of the above policies, the following sanctions will apply:

- Immediate rejection of the manuscript and all other manuscripts of this author (if any) submitted for publication in the journal.
- A prohibition for such authors to publish in the magazine for a minimum of 3 years.
- A prohibition of such authors to participate in the editorial board or to be invited to reviewers.
- Informing our partners about proven plagiarism or self-plagiarism.
- Informing sponsoring or supportive organizations about proven plagiarism or self-plagiarism.
